Volunteer Opportunities - Please contact us or fill out the form below if you are willing!

- 1. <u>Monitoring Lake (pH, dissolved oxygen, etc</u>...): We will need 1-2 people on each lake. You will need a boat and will be trained with the meter, which is easy. *Jack Schnell is the project lead.*
- <u>Clean Boats Clean Waters program</u>: An educational program at boat landings to prevent the spread of invasive species, especially the ones we want to keep out of our lakes! On major traffic weekends we need volunteers to take a short shift at the major boat landings. You touch base with boats coming in and out of the lake and pass out materials. *Paul Bussone is the project lead.*
- 3. <u>Skimmer/EcoHarvester operation</u>: We need more skimmer operators and we do provide the training. You should be good at maneuvering a boat, and don't worry, the Skimmer moves slow!! Also needed, are people to haul away the algae/weeds when the Skimmer returns to the landing, helps the efficiency immensely if the Skimmer operator doesn't have to do this. *Bill Wells and Alex Swanson are the project leads.*
- 4. <u>Healthy Lakes Grant Program</u>: The Healthy Lakes Program (<u>http://healthylakeswi.com/</u>) includes 5 simple and inexpensive best practices that improve the habitat and water quality on your lakeshore property. Rain gardens, Fish Sticks, buffer zones, infiltration, and diversion are tools we can use to help our lakes, and <u>there is a grant program that needs to be used!</u> If you would like to look at your property for consideration take pictures now and contact us! We need documentation now, and need to submit the application by December. We could use a project lead for this program. Kris would be an informational contact, and you would make sure to help the members gather the information for their project.
- 5. <u>Website/Video/Social Media Team</u>: We want to expand our educational efforts by boosting website information. *Kris is the project lead.*
